TO MAKE ALL THIS SYSTEM WORKING WE **NEED SEVERAL ACTIONS, here are some** proposals:


- Animation of the community



ICT AGRI FOOD CONTACT POINTS AND EDITORIAL BOARDS COORDINATORS

The Italian Ministry of Agriculture (MIPAAF) is responsible for providing you support on this task through:

- Supporting individual project partners in describing their innovations
- Act as **editorial boards of the online platforms**, once the innovation has been uploaded.
- Stimulate the discussion within the ERA-NET ICT-AGRIFOOD on the promotion of the online platform, once the content will be uploaded by the project partners.

SUPPORT PROJECT PARTNERS IN DESCRIBING THEIR INNOVATION

Once the researchers decide to upload an innovation on the Knowledge Incubator, he/she can need some **support** and assistance (eg. for understanding which language and communication approach to use, how to describe the project results etc...)

ICT-AGRI-FOOD will offer this type of service through a **Contact Point** which can support the description of innovation phase.

If needed, you can ask for a dedicated online me Order to discuss your specific innovation with Us and define how to present it in the Platform.

EDITORIAL BOARD of the online platform

Once the content are uploaded on the database, there is a need to double check them and see if they are readable, in the right language, addressing the target etc.

This work can be done by an editorial board that will then **approve** the publication of each innovation in the database or **send it back to the writer** for improvement or **improve it directly**.

The editorial board is not expected To review the content of the forms.

PROMOTION of the online platform

There will be a discussion forum within the ERA-NET ICT AGRIFOOD that will continue working on the promotion of the platform through:

- Editing and improving the graphic of the platform
- Presentation of the Knowledge Incubator in conferences, events with the aim of motivating actors in using it
- Connecting the online platform with national and European research portals and initiatives (e.g. European Partnerships for research and Innovation).

In order to make the platform attractive, we need innovations described in it!
