




ICT-AGRI-FOOD Calls

- 2022 ICT-AGR-FOOD Joint Call: More transparent AGRI-FOOD Systems for Consumers and other stakeholders along the food value chain based on ICT Technologies
- 2024 ICT-AGRI-FOOD Call "Tackling digitisation for sound agriculture and food systems"














Cofunded call 2019 "call for transnational, collaborative, inter-/transdisciplinary research projects on ICT-enables AGRI-FOOD systems"



- Topic 1 Data-driven ICT platforms and solutions to improve the sustainability of agri-food Systems
- Topic 2 Identify and address barriers for adoption of ICT technologies in the agri- food systems
- minimum of 3 independent entities from 3 different EU Member States or Associated Countries, seeking funding from a minimum of 3 different Funding Parties of 3 different countries participating in the Joint Call
- Limit of funding is maximum 500,000 Euro per country

19 cofunded projects selected




