LET'S START UPLOADING ONE INNOVATION PER PROJECT PARTNER

All the partners of research projects funded by the call ICT AGRI 2017, ICT AGRI/SusAn/ERA GAS 2018, ICT-AGRI-FOOD Cofund 2019 and ICT-AGRI-FOOD/SusAn/ERA GAS/SusCrop 2021 are asked to describe at least one innovation per project partner by the 30th of July 2022.

This implies that more innovations will be uploaded for the same project by all the project partners.

WHAT IS AN INNOVATION OFFER? WHICH TYPE OF INNOVATION CAN I UPLOAD?

An innovation offer is a digital technology or solution that can contribute to solve a specific problem in the agri-food system. In particular, innovative digital solutions are the result of transforming a problem or a need into a digital technology.

Innovations can be described as (OECD, Oslo Manual 2018):

- 1. **Product innovation**: a good or service that is new or significantly improved.
- 2. **Process innovation**: a new or significantly improved production or delivery method.
- 3. **Marketing innovation**: a new marketing method involving significant changes in product design or packaging, product placement, product promotion or pricing.
- 4. **Organisational innovation**: a new organisational method in business practices, workplace organisation or external relations.

HOW CAN I UPLOAD MY INNOVATION?

To upload your innovation, please go to the <u>ICT-AGRI-FOOD website</u> and login with your profile (you can use the same credentials created when you submitted your research proposal, or you can create a new profile if needed).

Once you are logged in, click on "Knowledge Incubator" from the menu on the top and select "Create your offer" (https://www.ictagrifood.eu/node/add/innovations). Please consider that the access will be denied if you did not login.

Now you can upload all the information related to your innovation, including a nice photo. You can always access and update the information on your innovation in the future.

Once you fill in the innovation sheet and save your content, there will be a **validation check performed by the MIPAAF team** before your innovation will be available online.
